
ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARENESS CAMP FOR GIRLS & WOMEN

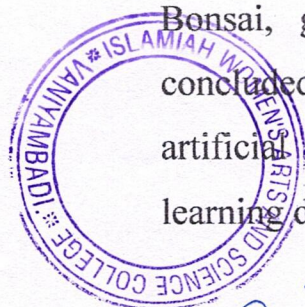
WORKSHOP – ARTIFICIAL BONSAI AN UNIQUE ART

10TH & 11TH FEBRUARY 2021

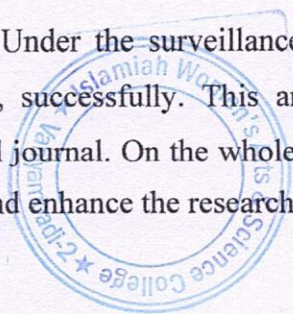
A REPORT
