

The program began with a prayer by a student of III B.Sc. Biochemistry with a welcome address from the IQAC Coordinator and a presidential address from Dr. M. Renu, Principal, IWASC. The Principal started the session noting the several achievements made by Indians over the years and the acknowledgement they have received world over. She believes every student to be gifted in some way or the other. To harness the talent after identifying is hard enough. One Day Workshop on 'Research Methodology'



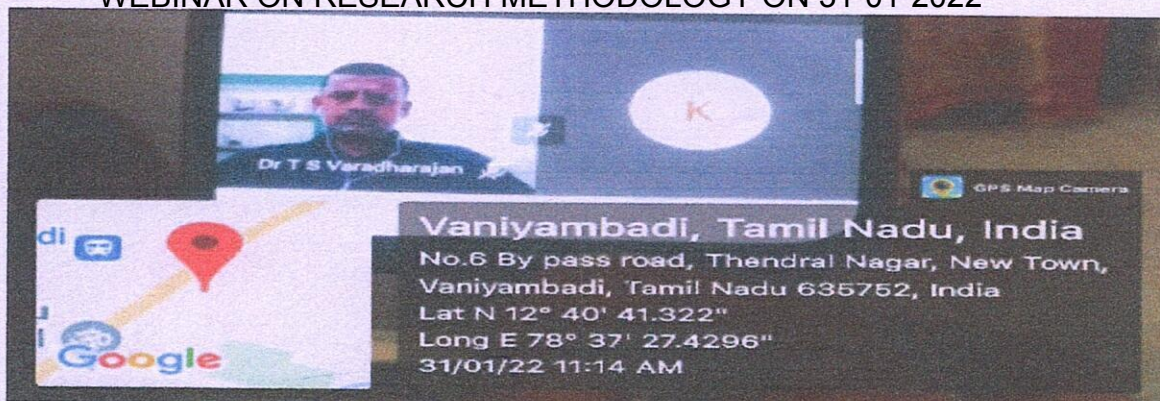


RESEARCH TOOLS AND TECHNIQUE

21-08-2021


